I am thrilled to let you know we are finally launching the FinTech Wales Coding Academy!!!

The initial pilot is an 8-10 week intensive programme and is starting on Monday 4th April. We hope to achieve great things with the pilot and then continue to deliver the Coding Academy on a regular basis.

Developed in close partnership with local Fintech employers, this **free** intensive programme is designed to provide individuals with relevant skills and qualifications in-line with current local job vacancies in the sector. It will run over:

- **8 weeks** for **graduates** (FE/HE) with a Level 4+ qualification in a relevant sector subject area, or
- **10 weeks** for **non-graduates** who are employed or recently unemployed with a relevant core skill set, and are looking to reskill/upskill to enter the Fintech industry. The first two weeks of this 10-week programme include additional intensive modules in coding, so even if you are self-taught with a passion for programming and no formal qualifications in this area, we encourage you to apply.

All participants will receive a weekly £150 training allowance. Partnering local FinTech organisations are committing to interviewing all those who complete the required modules.

Y Prentis - New Level 3 Apprenticeship Qualifications Sept 2022 - Are you prepared?

A ground-breaking change to qualifications for people planning to work in the construction and built environment sector in Wales is being introduced in September 2022. The move follows Qualifications Wales' sector review, titled **Building the Future**, which reviewed the current range of qualifications involving learning providers and employers, both large and small.

The post-16 qualifications include overarching Foundation and Core qualifications in Construction and Building Services Engineering, Progression qualifications in Building Services Engineering or Construction, and trade-specific qualifications for use on apprenticeship frameworks. **The Level 3 apprenticeship qualifications will be introduced in September 2022.**
