Customers who join through this route will receive £100 in M&S vouchers to help them get started, whether it's for clothes or lunches, M&S will also help with travel costs up to the first pay day to provide extra financial security, both measures will be underpinned by a "Buddy" scheme, ensuring each refugee joining M&S feels fully supported.

If a customer who is a refugee must move to another area whilst working for M&S, they will review their situation on a case-by-case basis to see where they can accommodate. Customers are also encouraged to apply for any other suitable positions here


